

LSU Sustainability Receives Keep Louisiana Beautiful Grant to expand Event-Based Recycling

BATON ROUGE – LSU Campus Sustainability has been awarded a Keep Louisiana Beautiful University Affiliate Grant to enhance recycling efforts at campus events. This funding provides critical infrastructure to more efficiently transport event-based ClearStream recycling bins, improving access to recycling at campus events such as home football games, Fall Fest, and other large-scale outdoor gatherings.

The \$5,400 grant enabled the university to acquire specialized ClearStream bin transport equipment designed to improve mobility and operational efficiency. This enhancement supports the expansion of event-based recycling, strengthens recycling rates, and reinforces LSU's commitment to waste reduction.

"The new equipment is a game changer," said Lisa Mahoney, assistant director of Campus Sustainability. "Staff will be able to integrate recycling bin deployment, collection, and teardown into our existing event waste management systems with minimal additional operating hours. This advancement helps pave the way for standardizing recycling at LSU events moving forward."
